Eufaula High School Drum Major Tryout Information

Tryouts will be conducted on Friday, March 23, 2024 starting at 4:00 pm. These tryouts will test correct pattern structure, creativeness (routine & salutes) preciseness (vocal commands), and confidence (interview, teaching.)

Practice Dates: Practices are from 3:30-4:45. They aren't required, but are highly encouraged.

- Tuesday, March 12 (FYI, this is also an e-day/Jr ACT day)
- Thursday, March 14
- Thursday, March 21

Important things to remember about tryouts

* Academic requirements will be the same as the athletic requirements (min C average)

* Candidates must have marched in the Eufaula Band a minimum of two (2) years, and be currently enrolled in the fall & spring EHS band classes, and enrolled in band class next year. * You will need to have a "uniform" for auditions. The tryout uniform will be a Eufaula HS band t-shirt, jeans and tennis shoes (or other appropriate "uniform" as chosen by candidates and approved by the band director.)

* Tryouts are closed to everyone but the judges, band director(s), candidates, or other appropriate Eufaula City Schools faculty/staff (i.e. principal, superintendent, etc.)

* Results sheets may be looked at by the candidates following the posting of the results, but may not leave the office of the band director.

* Results will be posted on the outside band room door (facing the band practice field) by 8:30 pm the evening of tryouts, and also posted on the band's facebook page.

<u>Costs</u>

* The uniform can cost between \$150-\$600, or more, but varies depending on the uniform. The uniform will be selected by the drum major, with the approval of the band director.

* Shoes cost around \$40 depending on the style.

* 1st year drum majors are required to attend a drum major/leadership camp this summer of the drum major's choice with the director's approval. Cost for this will be around \$300+, and will last 3-4 days in the summer. Options: Troy, Auburn, FSU, Alabama, JSU, Georgia, & others.

* Anyone that is selected MUST pay the full cost of the uniform by May 1, or they may be replaced, unless otherwise approved by the director. Uniforms must be ordered and planned by then in order to get them back by football season & camps must be pre-registered.

*There is also a \$66 band camp fee that will be due during band camp (July 22-26) along with the \$10 marching band tshirt.

SALUTES (16 counts maximum) (10 points, 5 points each)

- * one long (opening salute at the beginning of the show)
- * one short (closing salute at the end of the show)

VOCAL COMMANDS (12 points, 1 point each)

- * Attention
- * Parade Rest
- * Attention
- * Dress Center
- * Ready Front
- * Dress Right
- * Ready Front
- * Horns Up
- * Count off the fight song
- * Horns Down
- * Mark time (and count aloud [clapping] in 8s until halted, you should mark time also)
- * Halt

PATTERNS (18 points, 1 point for demonstration of each style)

- * 2/4
- * 3/4
- * 4/4
- * Demonstrate each pattern in the following 6 styles:
 - * slow
 - * fast
 - * legato slow
 - * legato fast
 - * marcato slow
 - * marcato fast

- * Conduct each pattern 4 measures
- * End each demonstration with a cut-off and horns down

CONDUCTING (20 points) to the song "Yaleo" arr. Jay Dawson

- * Cue anything big that you hear (entrances, dynamics, releases/cut-offs, etc.)
- * Change style, when you can, to match the music.
- * Don't necessarily "mirror" the whole time.
- * Be creative, but don't let it mess you up.
- * Always have CLEAR downbeats!

MARCHING/BODY CARRIAGE (10 points)

- * Demonstrated during the conducting routine
- * Demonstrated during the entrance of the tryout
- * Demonstrated during the entire tryout.

INTERVIEW (15 points)

- * Each judge, plus myself will ask you at least one question.
- * Answer honestly, and confidently.
- * Be clear, but don't ramble.

TEACHING (15 points)

- * You will be given a sheet to teach marching fundamentals.
- * You are being judged on your teaching ability and clarity of directions.

* Example: Mark time 4, forward march 4, right flank 8, mark time 4, left drag turn 90 degrees 4, backwards march 8, halt
